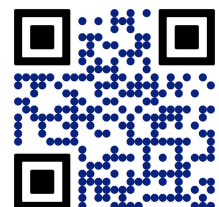

Fun & Safety



Individual tubes or noodles are welcome. Flotation devices should be for single person use only – please do not bring large rafts or floats. Tubes and noodles should be brought home daily – we will not store them at the club.

Parking: please be aware of parking in one space... with many families with SUVs parking can become a problem when people take up 1.5 spaces. Please be considerate of your fellow members. The small lot by the boating pond will be open for member-only parking on a limited basis. Any members exceeding the 5mph speed limit will be directed to park in the front lot. No guest parking beyond the front lot.

For our new families – swimming safety is our #1 priority!

Two things you need to know –

- a. **Swim diapers** with a suit that covers them are a **MUST** for those who aren't fully potty trained!
- b. **Non-swimmers MUST be supervised by an adult at the waters edge at all times....no exceptions.** Share this with grandparents and nannies – you are your child's first lifeguards and our staff is here to support you. Any non-swimmer (someone who can't comfortably cross the pool or pond independently) **MUST** have an adult at the water's edge at all times. Children requiring safety devices must have an adult with them if they go beyond the shallow ropes.

Our volleyball and tetherball courts are for those sports only – PLEASE advise your little ones that these are not areas for exploration (although we have many). The playground is a great place to dig and build and we invite members to bring their sand toys and be creative! Please do not use the tetherball or volleyball courts for digging and swinging.

Umbrellas should be set up no closer than 10 feet from the pond (sunny side only). We will continue to use the space outside the pool deck and along the pool fence area for a clear walkway this year... please do **NOT** set up your blankets and umbrellas in these areas.
